You are asked to accompany your child to Admission Day for approximately 45 minutes. You will meet their teacher who will answer any questions and outline aspects of class procedures, timetable, programmes and stationery requirements (school uniform is not required to be worn).

We were unable to hold our planned Orientation morning for students new to the school, which was scheduled for November 2021. As a result, we have modified the start of 2022 to allow new Year 7 students to spend a day at CSKI with their new teachers prior to the Year 8's starting.

### Regular School Days:

The Christchurch South Karamata Intermediate regular school day is 8.40am to 2.45pm. This will take effect from Thursday 3 February for Year 7 and Friday 4 February for Year 8 2021. Full uniform is required to be worn from these dates.

### Costs for School Activities:

We encourage full payment of contributions to cover costs associated with school activities on Admission Day where possible, by Eftpos or credit card. Alternative methods of payment can be arranged by ringing the school on 332 2408, or on

Admission Day. This includes auto payment/internet payment or time payment. For your guidance, an approximate figure to cover all major activities (including camp/Outdoor Education) is \$256 - \$368. A more exact figure will be on your invoice on the Admission Day. Receipts for tax purposes will be issued for all payments
