Dear Families,

Week 10 is Alternative Week at Christchurch South Intermediate! While a large group of our students are representing us in Nelson as part of the annual exchange with Broadgreen Intermediate, a fun and stimulating week is planned for our remaining students.

Each Pod will be running a full day of learning challenges to capture the student's interest! Students will rotate through the pods and take part in a number of selected activities. Students will begin and end each day in their original pod.

In Ngata, they will be taking part in science experiments, bread making or art.
In Rutherford, tabloid sports and other challenges are planned.
In Sheppard, students will be looking at Enterprising Business.
In Hillary, students will be looking at 'The World of Wearable Arts'.

For the day that the students are looking at The World of Wearable Arts, they will need to bring the following:
