2. Bring their own instruments (drum kit, amps & keyboard provided at the event)
3. Remain at the campus from 1:30pm until the concert performance time at 6:30pm. The concert is from 6:30pm - 9:30pm. Students are welcome to leave once their performance is completed - however the results will be announced at the end of the concert.
4. Bring their own packed meal and water bottles for dinner as no catering is provided at the venue. Last year the parents organised pizzas. If you would prefer to do this, please let Ms Maria Carter know.

The concert will commence at 6:30pm at Haeata Community College and the show is expected to run for approximately 3 hours. Door sales will be available on the day from 6pm, for \$10 per person.
